


Day 1: October 23, 2024 - Swachhta Run

The Swachhta Abhiyan 4.0 commenced with a *Swachhta Run* to create awareness about the importance of cleanliness and hygiene. Faculty, staff, and students participated enthusiastically to promote cleanliness. The run began at 7:00 AM from the college campus, covering a distance of 3 kilometres, and concluded back at the starting point. The event attracted the local community, who joined the participants in spreading the message of a clean and green environment.



Day 2: October 24, 2024 - Cleanliness Activity 1

On the second day of the Swachhta Abhiyan 4.0, the focus was on the *cleanliness of the college surroundings*. Faculty, staff and students were equipped with brooms, gloves, and trash bags. 


Day 3: October 25, 2024 - Cleanliness Activity 2


Day 4: October 26, 2024 - Cleanliness Activity 3 (Records Management)




Day 6: October 29, 2024 - Plantation Drive 2
